Overall Goals and Objectives

Conduct a participatory DFCNA process rooted in robust data collection that will identify the strengths, opportunities, challenges, and gaps present in the current services landscape to support an equitable and data-informed Service and Allocation Plan

Review literature and conduct initial research	Conduct community forums, survey, and focus groups	Complete equity and gaps analysis	Create DFCNA to support the Fund's Plan
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Community Forums

- 11 Community Forums conducted in all supervisor districts
- □ 547 attendees
 - Forums ranged from 17 to 81 with 50 as the average
- □ Majority (68%) were community members
- □ Almost two thirds (63%) were older adults
- Forums had diverse attendees
 - 35% were non-English speaking



Community Survey

- Survey completed in three ways: online, paperbased, and phone survey
- □ As of Friday, from the online survey
 - 221 provider surveys completed
 - 509 consumer surveys completed
- □ Among the consumers completing the survey
 - 366 older adults, 70 adults with disabilities, 20 caregivers, and 41 other



Community Survey Respondents

- We would need at least 30 responses to analyze any findings by a group
- These are the groups with the lowest response numbers:
 - District: 2, 6, 10, and 11 each have less than 30 responses
 - Race/Ethnicity: African American (24)
 - Language: Russian (1), Tagalog (4), and Vietnamese (4)



Focus Groups

- 30 Focus Groups will be conducted
 - 4 have been completed
 - 14 are scheduled for December
 - 12 have scheduling in progress
- Focus groups have been well attended



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Equity Analysis Objectives

Establish and apply a set of equity metrics
Establish a baseline of SF DAAS services and resources for aging adults and adults with disabilities with equity factors
