A. Review and approval of the Fiscal Year 2023-24 and FY 2024-25 DAS Budgets. (Presented by DAS Executive Director Kelly Dearman and HSA Deputy Director of Finance & Administration Dan Kaplan)

Presenters Deputy Director Kaplan and Executive Director Dearman outlined the Mayor's Budget citywide and let the commission know about projected budget deficits for the Human Services Agency (HSA) of 5% in FY23-24 and 8% in FY24-25. The State is expecting a \$22.5 B shortfall in FY23-24 due to lower revenues.

They then outlined the original and proposed budgets with exact percentages for all of HSA's departments. IHSS funding was then spoke on and then the new CARE COURTS budget was outlined, the DIGNITY FUND, followed by other DAS Community Services.

The DAS FY23-24 & FY24-25 Budget timeline was then outlined and the commissioners were notified of the timeline for the implementation dates.

President Knutzen thanked Presenters Dearman and Kaplan for all the hard work and details.

Commissioner Jung commented on how impressed she was on this budget and presentation and thanked both presenters. Appreciated how the presentation included CARE COURTS and there was no impact on the Disability Cultural Center and the new Online Directory and we are able to maintain and prioritize client assistance.

Presenter Kaplan thanked her and let the commissioners know there many people in both HSA and DAS who worked tirelessly to make this happen.

Vice President Spears wanted to add that she was very happy for the summary that Commissioner Jung provide and thanked them as well for the presentation.
